### The ECSEL Lighthouse Initiative in the field of Digital Industry

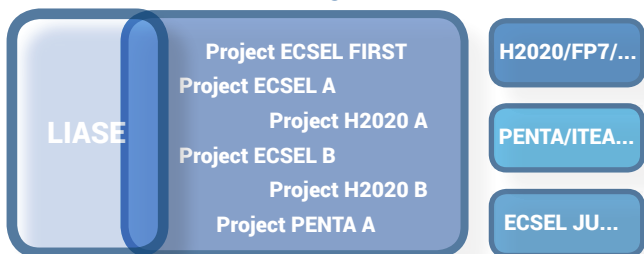

*A Lighthouse Initiative is a “container” of coordinated activities (=projects) coming from different programmes working towards common goals TOGETHER with a Lighthouse Initiative Advisory Service (LIASE) SUPPORTED by ECSEL JU BUT independant of the different programmes including ECSEL JU.*

They aim to give Europe differentiating factors to compete in the next generation of integrated solutions for electronic components and systems by engaging all needed actors in the supply/value chain and by connecting projects together from different European programmes like ECSEL, H2020, PPPs, Eureka, etc... These coordinating initiatives address as well, when necessary, non-technical measures such as legal issues, regulation or standardisation.
