Electronic Components and Systems for European Leadership Joint Undertaking (ECSEL Joint Undertaking) is a public-private partnership aimed at leveraging investments in the electronics sector in Europe. The ECSEL Joint Undertaking fosters Research and Innovation (R&I) collaboration between all stakeholders such as industry, public authorities, academia and research and technology organisations, pulling together and focusing efforts. The ECSEL Joint Undertaking's strategy is aligned with the Horizon 2020 Framework Programme and the programmes of Participating States to attract private investments and contribute to the effectiveness of public support by avoiding unnecessary duplication and fragmentation of efforts, thus contributing to the development of a strong and globally competitive electronics components and systems industry in the European Union. The ECSEL Joint Undertaking is based in Brussels, Belgium.

The ECSEL Joint Undertaking is set up for a period up to 31 December 2024 by Council Regulation (EU) No 561/2014 [\(1\)](#). The total costs of the R&I activities of the ECSEL Joint Undertaking have been in the range of 5 billion euro.

The ECSEL Joint Undertaking is currently composed of 30 staff.
